DESCRIPTION:

The Alice & Fraser Recreation Association is hiring one (1) Student for 6 weeks starting June 15, 2026. The position is 30 hours per week (Monday to Friday 12-6pm) with occasional evening and weekend work.

The Alice & Fraser Recreation Association is seeking a motivated and reliable Summer Student Maintenance Worker to assist with the upkeep and maintenance of community parks, recreation facilities, and grounds within the Township of Laurentian Valley throughout the summer season. The successful candidate will be an independent worker who follows direction well, self-motivated, and takes pride in maintaining clean, safe, and welcoming public spaces. This position is an excellent opportunity for a student who enjoys working outdoors and contributing to the local community.

DUTIES:

Reporting to the Facility Manager, the successful candidate will assist with a variety of maintenance duties, including:

- Lawn cutting, trimming, and whipper snipping
- Ball diamond & sports field maintenance, including preparing fields for games and events
- Assisting with general maintenance projects and repairs
- Providing support, when needed, with hall rental clean-up, including garbage removal, sweeping, mopping floors, and bathroom cleaning
- General groundskeeping and beautification of parks and facilities
- Performing various small labour and maintenance tasks as assigned

QUALIFICATIONS:

- Able to work independently
- Physically capable of performing assigned duties
- Reliable, punctual, and able to work independently or as part of a team
- Experience operating maintenance equipment such as grass trimmers, lawnmowers, etc. will be considered an asset
- Minimum Grade 12 student
- Registered as a full-time student during the preceding academic year and intending to return to school on a full-time basis during the next academic year
- Ability to set priorities, manage multiple tasks, and meet deadlines
- Ability to work with various members of the public

- Valid driver's licence required
- Access to a reliable personal vehicle
- Must have steel-toe boots

WORKING CONDITIONS:

- Some evening and weekend work may be required.
- May be subject to inclement weather and/or weather extremes during outdoor events and recreation maintenance requirements.

Wage is \$17.55 /hour for 30 hours per week. To be eligible you must have been registered as a full-time student during the preceding academic year and intend to return to school on a full-time basis during the next academic year.
