### LARGE ITEM COLLECTION

- Collection occurs on **your collection day** during the week specified on your collection schedule. Items are to be placed curbside no earlier than Sunday of Large Item Collection Week (May 28th & September 10th)
- Scrap metal & Non-Freon appliances, Freon appliances and Electronics must be placed in separate piles as they are collected
- Small items or material placed out in garbage bags or cardboard boxes WILL NOT BE collected.
- Remove all fluids, gasoline and batteries from items (i.e. lawn mower)
- Material must be manageable by two (2) people and cannot exceed 80 lbs (36kg), 27ft<sup>3</sup> (.76m<sup>3</sup>) or 6 ft (1.8 m)




